What is social service?

Social services are a range of public services provided by the government, private, profit and non-profit organizations. These public services aim to create more effective organizations, build stronger communities, and promote equality and opportunity. Social services include the benefits and facilities such as education, food subsidies, health care, police, fire service, job training and subsidized housing, adoption, community management, policy research and lobbying.

Programs

1. **Support for marginalized citizens and groups**
 - Support for long term unemployed coming from low income families
 - Vocational education and training for unemployed
 - Special support programs for impaired and disabled
2. **Social enterprise** - The CDI is functioning as social enterprise providing products and services and the income is allocated to support its self-sustainability and to provide support for marginalized groups.
3. **First aid** - First aid training and services for local citizens
4. **Capacity building** for local grass root groups and organizations for emergency situations

5. **Volunteering** - The CDI in continuation works on recruitment and training of volunteers, their capacity building, and deployment in case of emergency/needs.
6. **Community services and support in case of emergency** - The CDI provides support in case of emergency by recruitment of volunteers in case of floods, and other natural disasters.

7. Refugees

- The CDI and its project partners have organized series of events and activities in order to provide initial support for integration of the refugees.
 - Online Open Educational resources/platforms have been created in several languages to facilitate the integration of the refugees in new environment and to provide easier access for social services.
 - **Resource center** - The CDI provides services for local action and community groups, training facilities and office space, as well as training resources.
8. **Prison education and probation** – the CDI provides training financial and technical support to prisoners to increase their competitiveness on the labor market, and also serve as verified institution for probation.

Certified training provider institution

- The CDI offer certified programs and training in:
 - Daycare support for elderly people
 - Daycare support for disabled

Europe aid volunteers

In the period of 2018 to 2020 the CDI participate in a program for verification and host institution within Europe Aid Volunteers program. The leading partner is Danish Refugee Council.

Cooperation with public institutions
